Bangor Christian Schools offers several tuition payment plans:

12 month.....Payments begin June 20th and are due each month on the 20th thru May 20th.
 10 month.....Payments begin August 20th and are due each month on the 20th thru May 20th.
 4 PayplanPayments are due August 15th, October 30th, January 15th and March 30th.
 Semester.....Payments are due August 15th and January 15th.
 AnnuallyPayment is due by August 15th.

An installment fee of \$4 per payment is charged after the first payment to cover the cost of servicing each account. Invoices for tuition due are sent by mail at the beginning of each month.

When the account becomes one day late, a notice will be sent home to inform the parent(s) that tuition must be paid in ten (10) days in order for their children to continue the privilege of attending Bangor Christian Schools. Tuition payments not received when due will be assessed a \$10.00 late fee.

Tuition-Reducing Options

Church Members Scholarships – available from the pastor of the church your family attends. Your pastor may contact Pastor Mick at Bangor Baptist Church (947-6576) in regard to this scholarship. This scholarship is designated for first-time families enrolling at Bangor Christian Schools.

Alumni Scholarships – for children of BCS alumni and is transferable, meaning that if a graduate of Bangor Christian Schools contacts us on your behalf, you will receive a scholarship. This scholarship is designated for first-time families enrolling at Bangor Christian Schools.

Maine Children’s Scholarship Fund – application for this scholarship is enclosed. Please note the income guidelines on the back, which are based on the **adjusted gross income** on your **2010** federal income tax return. The deadline for applications for the 2011-12 school year is **April 30, 2011**.

BCS Tuition Credits – please contact the principal concerning tuition credits.

BCS Financial Aid – application for financial aid is enclosed. This application and necessary information must be returned no later than **July 10, 2011** for the 2011-12 school year.

Tuition Discounts for Pastor – every full-time pastor in the Greater Bangor Area is eligible for a 50% discount for their own children.
