You do not have to be of Christian faith to attend Bangor Christian Schools. If you are of a certain faith, then we would try to make sure you would not feel uncomfortable in another's home.

We require these things from you:

1. A valid passport
2. A valid Visa
3. A telephone interview with Mrs. Burgason
4. A yearly physical (which should be done in the U.S.)
5. Medical records (immunizations)
6. Official transcripts from middle and high school (in English)
7. A \$500.00 dollar deposit, which will be applied to total costs, but will be forfeited if the student does not come.
8. Two letters of recommendation in English from a teacher. (This must be sent to Mrs. Burgason directly through the mail before they arrive here in the U.S.)

Rules of living in America:

1. There will be no use of alcohol, illegal drugs or tobacco or you will be automatically sent home.
2. We may switch homes for you once, and then be offered a school with a dorm. If that does not work out in the dorm, you will be sent home. You will have to pay for another plane ticket to get to your new home if we have to switch you.
3. You will obey the rules of each home. (Yes you will be required to do different things, but that is part of the experience) Example: Doing chores at home, coming home by a certain time, etc...
4. You cannot drive ANYTHING with a motor i.e. cars, snowmobiles, four wheelers, motorcycles, mopeds, etc....
5. You will attend church with your host family twice a week.
6. You will participate in at least two extra curricular activities per year.
7. You must be able to pass the TOEFL (a grade of 60 or higher) or you will not graduate from our high schools.
8. No high school students are allowed to live without adult supervision. Students found to be living alone will be asked to withdraw or will be switched to a host family.
9. To be allowed to continue studying at an American high school, the student must have a "C" average.
10. There will be no traveling in the U.S. unless accompanied by a member of your host family or your own biological family.
11. All students will need to eat one meal per day which consists of meat, vegetables, and a starch. If you do not eat once per day you will be asked to leave and immediately go back to your home country.
12. If a student breaks any of these rules, the school has a right to send you back to your home country without any refund of any money.
13. The student is responsible to pay for going out to eat, the movies, any sports related equipment, personal hygiene items, etc...
14. Upon arriving at Bangor Christian Schools, the student will read and agree to abide by all of the rules and principles stated in the Student Handbook.
